- Provide resources and direction to group leaders for doing group online (for those not doing it already)
- Gather information (doing it this week) on needs in our church through community
 groups. Each group will seek to meet one another's needs unless it exceeds what the
 group can do and then group leaders will communicate that to Pastor Travis, who leads
 our community groups and we will coordinate best strategies for care.
- Meet with community group leaders online for equipping, discussion, and prayer.
